Hunger

Eradicate extreme poverty and hunger

Target for 2015: Halve the proportion of people living on less than a dollar a day and those who suffer from hunger.



Education

Achieve universal primary education

Target for 2015: Ensure that all boys and girls complete primary school.



Human Rights

An essential element in the protection of human rights is a widespread knowledge and understanding among people of what their rights are and how they can be defended.



Freedom of Belief

In November 1981, governments signed a Declaration on the Elimination of All Forms of Intolerance and of Discrimination Based on Religion or Belief. That document included the right to "establish and maintain" places of worship; to "write, issue and disseminate" religious publications; to "observe days of rest and to celebrate holidays"; and to "establish and maintain communications with individuals and communities in matters of religion and belief at the national and international levels."



Women

Promote gender equality and empower women

Target for 2005 and 2015: Eliminate gender disparities in primary and secondary education preferably by 2005, and at all levels by 2015.



Poverty/Financing for Development

- + Develop further an open trading and financial system that includes a commitment to good governance, development and poverty reduction-- nationally and internationally.
- + Address the least developed countries' special needs, and the special needs of landlocked and small island developing states.
- + Deal comprehensively with developing countries' debt problems.
- + Develop decent and productive work for youth.
- + In cooperation with pharmaceutical companies, provide access to affordable essential drugs in developing countries.
- + In cooperation with the private sector, make available the benefits of new technologies-- especially information and communications technologies.
